VOLUNTARY CYBER INCIDENT REPORTING SCHEME

No: **MMN-22/2021**

1. The purpose of this Merchant Marine Notice is to encourage all ship owners, operators and any other interested party of Panamanian flag vessels to report incidents resulting from any cyber event.
2. The Voluntary Cyber Incident Notification Plan will be available from November 2021, through the following link <https://forms.office.com/r/PbXePQsrx5>
3. The information received is strictly confidential and will be used by the Panama Maritime Administration for the analysis of trends and patterns to which vessels are exposed in terms of cyber risk.
4. This Administration recommends to the all ship-owners and operators to take the necessary steps to safeguard shipping from current and emerging threats and vulnerabilities related to digitization, integration and automation of processes and systems in shipping to ensure that cyber risks management should be seen as complementary to existing security and safety risk management requirements contained in the International Safety Management Code (ISM) Code and the International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code.
